We will have a Tenebrae Service. If you have never attended and are curious as to what a Tenebrae Service is, here you go... (adapted from www.gotquestions.org) Tenebrae is Latin for "shadows" or "darkness" (or "night" or "death"). The purpose is to remember the somber events that occurred in Jesus' life from the entrance into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday through the night of Jesus' burial on Good Friday. The most distinctive aspect of the service is the use of candles. It starts with candles lit, but one by one, the flames are extinguished as Scripture readings are shared to tell the story of Holy Week. There are 16 Scripture readings and we NEED READERS.
