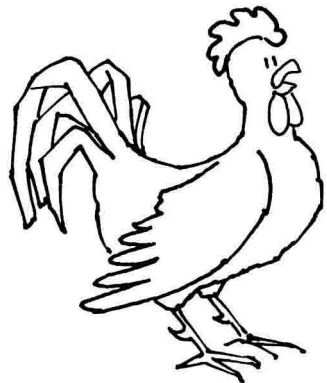
Jesus had told the disciples that one of them would betray Him and one of them would deny Him three times before the rooster crowed. Judas betrayed Him.




