




The scripture will be broken down into 16 readings. To start, sixteen candles will be lit, one candle will be extinguished after each reading. *Pre-Recorded.






Jesus had told the disciples that one of them would betray Him and one of them would deny Him three times before the rooster crowed. Judas betrayed Him.




And, after the third time that early morning, the rooster crowed.
