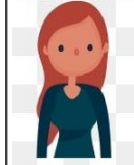

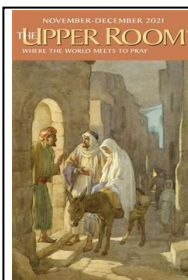


FREE Office Furniture
