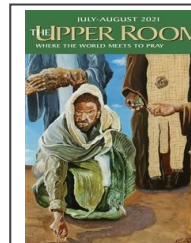
Memorial Garden & Columbarium - DEADLINE NEAR for MATCHING FUNDS
