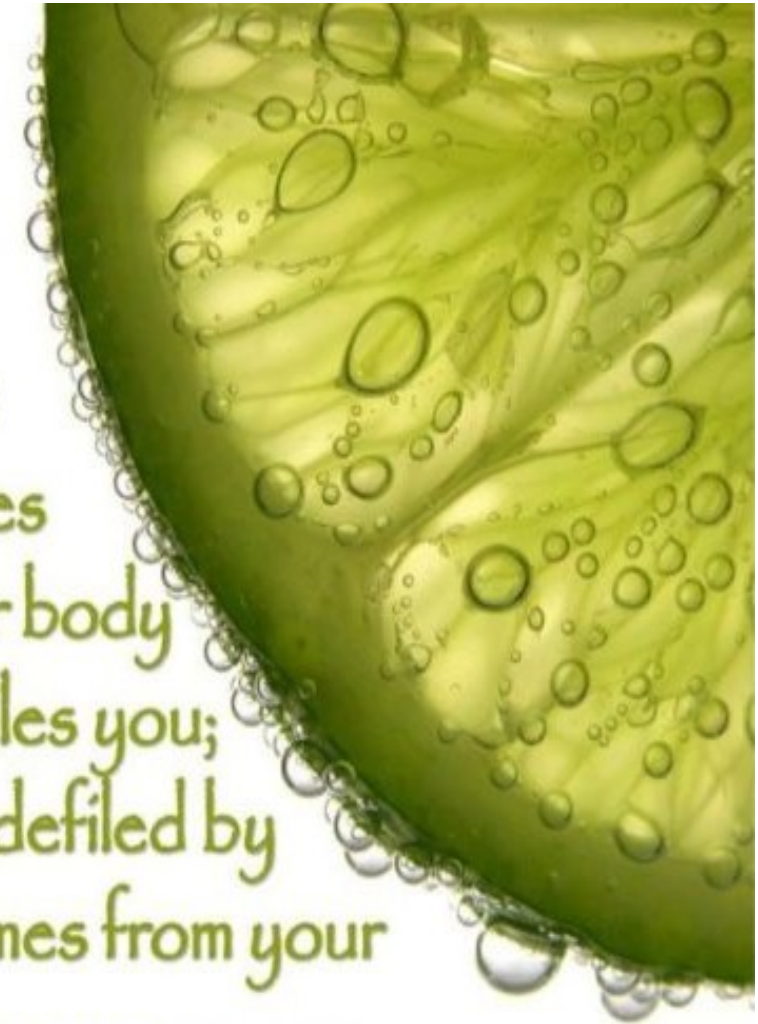

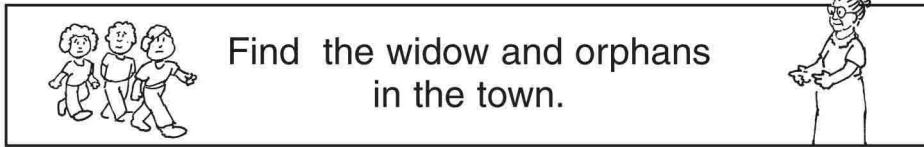


**PMUMC's Walking TACO/Hot Dog/Respite Booth**
